

Contract for concerts at The Goshen Theater

This contract applies to concerts at the Goshen Theater that charge admission. It is designed to maximize the success of your show and future shows at the Goshen Theater. The Goshen Theater is a community service, not a business venture, and the details of this agreement are intended to reflect that.

The event organizer mentioned throughout this document could be a concert promoter, band, or anyone else who enters into this contract in order to hold an event.

Admissions

The Goshen Theater will take 50% of the admission proceeds up to \$500. This money will be used to pay for sound technicians, other needed workers, to keep the utilities turned on in the building and to keep the sound equipment running. We do not intend to make a profit.

At the conclusion of the show, the event organizer will be given 50% of the admission proceeds up to \$500 and then 100% of whatever is brought in on top of that. This person, the event organizer, will then be responsible for distributing that money to all bands involved in whatever way was previously agreed upon by those parties. The Goshen Theater will not be involved in determining what percentage of this money each band receives.

Performance Duration

Total performance time should not exceed 2.5 hours. For example, if you are holding a concert and the first band starts at 8pm, then the final band should finish their performance by 10:30pm. This gives enough time for 3 bands, the first 2 bands playing for ½ hour and the final band for 1 hour, assuming 15 minute staging time between bands.

Products and Merchandise

Bands keep 100% of proceeds from merchandise sold by them. The Goshen Theater will not provide anyone to help with selling merchandise; this is the responsibility of the bands.

The Goshen Theater will keep 100% of proceeds from products sold by the venue. This will typically consist of any concessions that are at the show.

Conduct

The Goshen Theater is a “family friendly” venue and the following restrictions apply.

- Entertainment must not include profanity, innuendos, discriminatory language or behavior.
- There may be no alcohol or drugs on the premises, no persons may be intoxicated or otherwise impaired, and persons should not smell of alcohol.
- There may be no smoking inside of the theater.
- No performances should be a “soapbox” for isolating political or social statements (as decided by the staff at the Goshen Theater).
- No equipment owned by the Goshen Theater will be damaged during the event.

The Goshen Theater reserves the right to withhold payment for any of the above stated violations.
